

## SAP 2017-18

### General Sanitation

- a) Efforts are currently made to make ODF declaration in Cannanore Cantonment in FY 2017-18.
- b) Disposal of unserviceable items through public auction will be carried out in FY 2017-18.
- c) Trees will be painted to give an orderly look to the Cantonment area.

### TOILETS & GROUP LATRINES

- a) 4 No.s of Portable toilets shall be procured for installation in Cantonment park in Civil area in FY 2017-18, budget – Rs. 3,00,000
- b) If, zero waste project which is pending for approval of PDDE vide: letter No.2284/CDP/2015 dated 30.03.2016 is sanctioned, then latrine linked bio gas plant will be installed near 3 group latrines in Cantonment area. FY 2017-18 Budget – Rs. 16,78,310

### Door to Door garbage collection and its segregation into bio-degradable and non bio-degradable waste;

- a) Presently, door to door garbage collection is carried out on a rented goods carriage auto. A tipper auto will be procured for door to door garbage collection in FY 2017-18. Budget – Rs. 3.50 lakhs.
- b) 2 no.s of tricycles will be purchased to make the door to door collection more effective in Burnacherry Civil area in FY 2017-18. Budget – Rs. 50,000/-

### Management of trenching grounds as per MSW Rules 2000

The following activities are proposed to be undertaken for the next 2 years.

- a) Vermin composting of organic waste at the trenching ground is proposed and will be commenced soon.
- b) Zero waste project will be implemented if sanctioned which will include Windrow composting unit in trenching ground for converting bio-degradable wastes in trenching ground. Budget Rs. 66,56,600.

Proper cleaning of public places and introduction of mechanical cleaning devices to keep roads and steets spick and span

Road sweeping machine is proposed to be purchased for cleaning of roads.

ROADS:

- a) A new road will be constructed in Burnacherry connecting Commonwealth trust road to Mill road.
- b) An all-weather paving Road will be made in trenching ground for smooth transportation of conservancy lorry to the trenching ground in all seasons.  
Budget in FY 2017-18 is Rs. 10,00,000.

DRAINS & SEWERS

The following activities are proposed to be undertaken for the next 5 years.

- a) There are open drains in Cantt. area measuring 6 Km which will be renovated in the phased manner. Cantt. Board also proposed to convert all the drains into underground drains. Expected expenditure in FY 2017-18 is Rs. 50 lakhs.
- b) A soak pit will be constructed in Baby Beach seawards drain in Sy. No. 25 to drain of accumulated water in the sea end drain. A pump is being actively engaged to pump the accumulated water into the sea.
- c) Consultant will be engaged for survey & DPR preparation of sewer lines and sewer treatment plant, which is proposed to be completed by 31.03.2019. Budget in FY 2017-2018 is Rs. 5,00,000.

Daily clearance of dustbins and cleaning of surrounding areas:

- a) The existing conservancy lorry has completed 15 years of service life. A new lorry has to be procured. FY 2017-18, Budget – Rs. 15,00,000
- b) Dustbins will be painted every six months.

Developing and disseminating cleanliness logos and messages which remind people about the importance of keeping their environment clean

- a) Solid waste management bye-laws will be strictly implemented.
- b) People will be made more aware of sanitation through suchithwa sabha.
- c) Paper bags and cloth bags will be made and locally distributed with co-operation of women's self help group Kudumbashree.

Enhanced emphasis on planting trees and protecting existing trees

- a) Trees will be planted in front of trenching ground and vacant areas to make a green belt area on the periphery of trenching ground.

Cleaning of Cantt. Land & erecting boundary wall around vacant land

- a) Cantonment coconut garden in GLR Sy. No.41 will be fenced and cultivated regularly. Budget in FY 2017-18 is Rs. 8,00,000.

Cantonment fund buildings

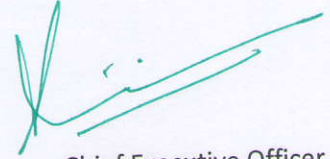
- a) Proposal to build Cantt Staff quarter with all facilities. This will be completed in 2 years. Expected expenditure is as follows. Budget for FY 2017-18 is Rs. 67,00,000 (phase - I)

Interest of workers

- a) More Protective gears will be provided to workers to ensure their health & safety. FY 2017-18 budget is Rs. 70,000.
- b) Periodical medical checkups of workers will be done in co-operation with District Hospital, Kannur.
- c) Annual health checkup of all Cantonment staff will be done at District Hospital Kannur.

Curbing stray cattle & dogs menace

- a) Cannanore Cantonment Board is about to enter a MOU between Kannur Municipal Corporation for ABC programme for control of dog menace. Budget in FY 2017-18 is Rs. 1,00,000.
- b) Cattle pound is being renovated by repairing the compound walls, gate, well for detaining stray cattle which will be caught by Cantonment safaikarmacharis. Budget in FY 2017-18 is Rs. 50,000.
